City of Joondalup Youth School Awards

The City of Joondalup is committed to developing young people in the community and in addition to a range of youth services and events, makes available the City of Joondalup Youth Awards.

These awards are to recognise and reward young people in the City by encouraging them to commit to further studies.

Students in year 10 or equivalent are able to apply for an amount of \$1,000 to assist them in completing their ATAR or general/VET/alternate studies.

Eligibility

1. Any student aged between 15 – 18 years, currently in Year 10, is eligible to nominate for one award, to assist them in continuing their studies beyond year 10 at an educational institution within the City of Joondalup.
2. The student must be a resident of the City of Joondalup.
3. Students can apply as an individual or be nominated by an educational institution.
4. The educational institution must complete the “Confidential Report” for each application.
5. The educational institution must complete the “Educational Institution – Financial Information” form for each application.
6. The student is ineligible if they are in receipt of another academic scholarship over the value of \$500.00. If they have previously received a scholarship for a different category such as sport or arts, the student is not precluded from this award.

Award Categories

1. ATAR.
2. General, VET, alternative education program (including TAFE).

How are the applications assessed?

Applications will be assessed based on the application form, subject to the following factors:

1. All eligibility criteria for the Awards are met and conditions of funding are accepted.
2. Appropriate accountability processes are in place.
3. All relevant documentation has been attached including semester reports and the “Confidential Report” from the educational institution.
4. All previous funds have been successfully acquitted.
5. A panel selected by the City of Joondalup will review the applications and will select the successful applicants.

Funding Conditions

1. Funds (\$1,000 GST inclusive) will be forwarded to the educational institution to be allocated to fees and other education expenses at the educational institution’s discretion. The educational institution must be a recognised secondary school, (government or independent) or alternative education program within the City of Joondalup.

2. The recipient of the grant has an ABN and is GST registered.
3. The fund administrator is responsible for sending the funds and a Recipient Created Tax Invoice (RCTI) may be issued by the educational institution.
4. It is a requirement that a formal acquittal of funds is completed by the educational institution in accordance with the City’s acquittal process.
5. Only entries completed on the official application form and a report from the educational institution supporting the student’s application will be accepted.
6. It is expected that the City’s financial support will be acknowledged through means such as advertising, promotion and any media publicity associated with the Awards scheme. Approval will need to be given to use the City’s logo where appropriate.
7. To take part in the Youth Awards, all entrants must consent to the City of Joondalup using photos of the entrant for all promotional material produced by the City and its events including, but not limited to, all future promotion for this particular event, Annual Reports, City News, the City of Joondalup website and the City’s social media channels.

Applicants will need to incorporate separate attachments where required.

Applicants and the Educational Institution will be advised of the outcome of their application within two months of the closing date of applications.
